## Scattered Crowd Access information

Scattered Crowd is one of several off site installations that are part of the Focus on Forsythe season. It involves over 7000 helium filled balloons, and is on the first floor in a disused good shed in Kings Cross. We regret to say that this is the only work in the season that is not wheelchair accessible. However there is a film of it currently available online, and an archival film of the season will be made after the event which will also go up online.

The space is reached from Wharf Road, which is off York Way. As you enter the site there is a gentle slope down to the Goods Shed, then a set of 6 stairs to reach the ground floor of the space. In the centre of the ground floor area is a staircase which has approximately 30 steps in 3 sets that take you up to the first floor.

The installation is all around the first floor which has an flat wooden floor throughout.

Apart from some chairs for the elderly or those with small children the only thing in the space is the 7000 balloons and the sound scape. For those with visual impairments the sound scape can be felt by holding one of the balloons in the space, which seem to hum and vibrate with the deep resonance of the gentle score.

The exit has 37 steps down to ground level in three stages of 7, 15 and another 15 steps. The exit takes you back onto Wharf Road.
